Homophones

Words that have the same pronunciation, but different spellings and meanings are called Homophones.

1) rode / road

I rode a horse.The road was very rough.

2) son / sun

His son is very intelligent.The sun shines brightly.

3) story / storey

The story was very interesting.I do not know on which storey he lived.

4) heal / heel

The wound will heal slowly.The heel of the shoe was broken.

5) cot / caught

The baby slept soundly in his cot.The police caught the thief.

6) write / right

Do write it neatly.Take a right turn.

7. weak / week.

He is very weak after the illness.
Last week I went shopping.

8. sail / sale

The sail was blue in colour.
My mother wants to go to the sale.

9. meet / meat

Please meet me tomorrow.
The meat was stale.

10. plain / plane

The plain ground was good to play on.
The plane crashed.

11. their / there

It is their house.
Your books are kept there.

12. mail / male

The mail will come tomorrow.
He said no male was allowed.

13. sea/see

The sea is very rough today.
Can you see the kite?

14. blue/blew

The sky is blue.
He blew the whistle.

15. ate/eight

I ate the apple.
There are eight eggs in the basket.
